Message from the Grand Knight

July 1st, 2010

This is the start of a new fiscal year for our Council and also a changing of the guard. It is an honor and privilege to be our Council's new Grand Knight. Along with new Deputy Grand Knight, Dan Heye and our fellow officers, we wish to extend a heart-felt thank you to Past Grand Knight Greg Lum and his leadership team for their dedication to the mission of the Knights of Columbus. Under Greg's leadership we served our church and community with countless hours of volunteering and brought Jesus' message of hope to many people. Kudos and enjoy the title "Past Grand Knight"!

The Council approved a 2010 – 2011 budget at the June Business Meeting and we have a full calendar of activities for the coming year. We encourage all of our Knights to step up in any capacity to help carry the load. Not everyone can attend the Business Meetings on the first Wednesday of each month, but everyone can be a "24 hour Knight." All you have to do is volunteer two hours per month to one of our programs/meetings and you will have contributed 24 hours of service by the end of the year... a significant contribution.

The Council leadership team met in June to establish goals for the coming year:

1. Focus on prayer to achieve our mission.
2. Promote a Sacrament of the Year – Reconciliation.
3. Officers meet with Pastor 4-6 times per year.
4. Increase membership – achieve the Father McGivney award (5% net increase).
5. Activate a Hispanic Round Table.
6. Broaden member involvement in activities.
7. Knight Retention – Honor Knights for achievements and milestones.
8. Balanced Budget – Monthly status report.
9. Evaluate and increase general fundraising.
10. Increase *Pennies for Heaven* contribution.
11. Meetings – Have pre-printed agenda. One hour length. Social time at end.
12. Create Pre-event form with date, budget, and volunteers request.
13. Create standardized post-event report form.
14. Earn Star Council Award (Meet Supreme goals for Programs, Membership, and Insurance.)

Goal #2 is promoting the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Everyone is encouraged to go to Reconciliation (Confession) once a month as a way to humbly strengthen our relationship with God. It is a cleansing process that will remove unnecessary baggage and allow Jesus' to generously share his graces with our Council so we can achieve His work through our activities.

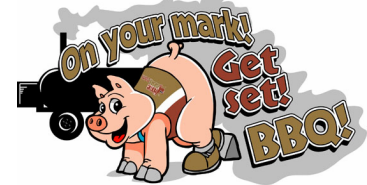
