### The Power of Intercessory Prayer

One of the things that we are called to do is pray on behalf of others. We do this because we have been touched deeply and profoundly by the love of God in Christ and we want everyone to experience the unfathomable riches we have in Him.

Because we live in a world where we have a lot of instant gratification and seek instant results for things, we can begin to grow weary and doubt the importance of praying on behalf of others. When we fail to see results we can begin to wonder if praying for others really makes that big of a difference. Have you ever stopped to think about how the Mass is faithfully offered for the "peace and salvation of all the world" (Eucharistic Prayer III) everyday throughout the world? Every time the Mass is offered we pray faithfully for the completion of Christ's mission to be brought about. This is a beautiful gift to the Church but we need to make it personal. To really pray along with the Mass means bringing what it means into our daily lives.

One of the ways I have experienced God's love is when people tell me that they are praying for me. I know my own weaknesses and to know that someone cares enough for me to pray for me that I might fulfill God's will faithfully each day

brings great joy into my heart and I've always seen it as a sign of God's love for me. I too pray for the people God brings into my life and I have found it helpful to have a prayer list so that I can remember various needs and people who have asked for prayer. Part of our common ministry as the baptized is to share in the priesthood of Christ. Priests offered prayer and sacrifices on behalf of the people, so every baptized person is called to think and pray for others and to make sacrifices for them. It's a fundamental part of our basic Christian identity.

Do you know someone around you who is having a difficult time? Write their name down and spiritually adopt them by asking God's protection and blessing for them. You will see that God will give you a real heart for his people and you will find little ways to express the love that God puts into your heart for your neighbors. Intercessory prayer prays for God's blessing and providence for others, but the amazing thing we discover is that our heart is touched and blessed also! By not putting ourselves first we experience grace and blessing and we share in the mission of the Church to further the Kingdom of God in our daily lives.
